IGCSE Basic Curriculum will be introduced in 10th grade and if results are 70% or higher in core subjects, they may choose to sit for IGCSE exams. If students are not able to achieve 70% or higher, students can continue to cover the IGCSE Basic Curriculum in 11th grade so that students may have the option of taking IGCSE exams before they graduate or advancing to AS Cambridge Curriculum if their results surpass 70% in 11th grade. Students will not sit for AS exams in 12th grade unless their results are 70% or higher.</p>	<p>ESL classes with minimal subject related work, till required English proficiency is reached OR ESL classes and MPA Curriculum in 10th Grade. Option to join Cambridge track for 11th and 12th grade if results are 70% or higher in core subjects. If results are lower than 70% in core subjects, IGCSE Basic Curriculum will continue so that students may have the option of taking IGCSE exams before they graduate or advancing to AS Level Cambridge Curriculum if their results surpass 70% in 11th grade. Students will not sit for AS exams in 12th grade unless their results are 70% or higher.</p>	<p>ESL classes with minimal subject related work, till required English proficiency is reached OR ESL classes and IGCSE Basic Curriculum in 11th grade. Option of taking IGCSE exams before they graduate or advancing to AS Level Cambridge Curriculum if their results surpass 70% in 11th grade.
